



The Oak Leaf Digital Audio Visual Trophy
15th April 2011
RULES

1. This competition is for digital-audio visual sequences.
The **Oak Leaf Trophy** will be awarded to the club submitting the sequence judged to be the best.
2. It is only open to member clubs of the Southern Photographic Federation.
3. Up to 4 sequences per club. Entry details must specify order in which titles are to be projected. **Entry is free.**
4. Sequences will be shown in random order. In the event of a large number of entries, the higher priority, eg A, B etc will be projected.
5. No sequence may exceed 5 minutes in length. Video/stop motion is not allowed. Animation of slides must be limited to 10% or less of run time.
6. The subject for the sequence is at the discretion of the submitting club, but must not be of a nature to cause offence.
7. The photography and sequence production must be the original work, and copyright, of one or more members of the club submitting the entry. There is no limit to those involved.
8. The name of the submitting club, nor the authors, must not be mentioned in the credits, nor anything that may identify the submitting club within the sequence.
9. Credits for the music or musicians are not allowed.
10. All entries must be stand-alone run time, ie. it must not use additional software for projection, with digital production supplied on CD ready to transfer to hard disk. The accepted format is for PC only.
11. The use of images from the public domain is forbidden. However, scans of old photographs or press cuttings may be included to assist a narrative or as part of a montage, or other effect, but may not be more than 10% of the images used in the sequence.
12. The use of copyright music in the sequence must be supported by the relevant licence details. Non copyright music should state where obtained.
13. The maximum size of the projected image in the sequence is to be 1024 pixels wide by 768 pixels high. (Native resolution of the projector).
14. Entries should reach NHPS co-ordinator by 1st April 2011. The entry form is on our website <http://www.nhphoto-soc.org/Oak Leaf Entry Form.pdf>
15. CD's of the entries can be collected on the night or returned by post if sufficient postage and return address included.
16. The competition is open to a maximum of 20 participating clubs, on a first come first entered basis.
